FORT WILLIAM ROTARY DONATION

Thank you Thunder Bay for your buying Rotary House Draw ticket, because you purchased a ticket many charities in Thunder Bay receive financial support, St. Joseph's Foundation included. On May 31 members joined staff from St. Joseph's Hospital for our tour of the site and to see first hand the equipment purchased through their donations since 2019. New equipment purchased included portable lifts and slings, upgrades to the ultrasound and xray equipment, wheelchairs, bariatric bed and Harmonie bathtub. This year, Fort William Rotary has donated \$100,000 toward the new Nurse Call System. Nurse Call Systems are a crucial part of client care and safety, providing a way to contact the nursing station. It's called a system because it incorporates a number of aspects: display units at Nursing Stations, dome lights giving visual indicators where a call has been activated, bathroom stations to call for help, 'code' stations to automatically call for supports (eg: a Code Blue), bedside devices where clients can have two-way conversation with staff, and more.
